Work Progress

During this period the first year mark of QVIZ was passed which carried with it financial and management reporting.

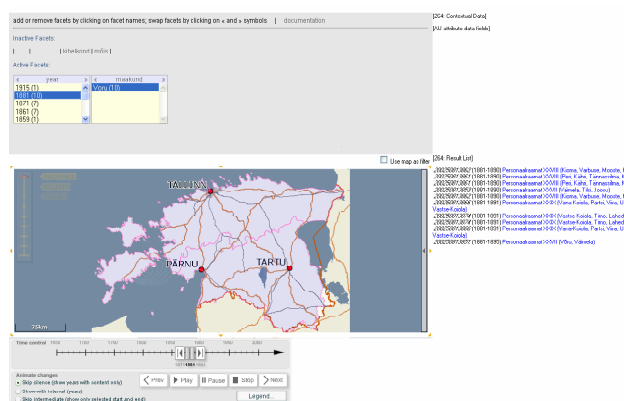
From the Publishable Executive Summary:

“The work on implementing core components of the system, including social software functions, visualization and knowledge building, led to software output available to users under two prototype portals which we will be integrated at a later stage .

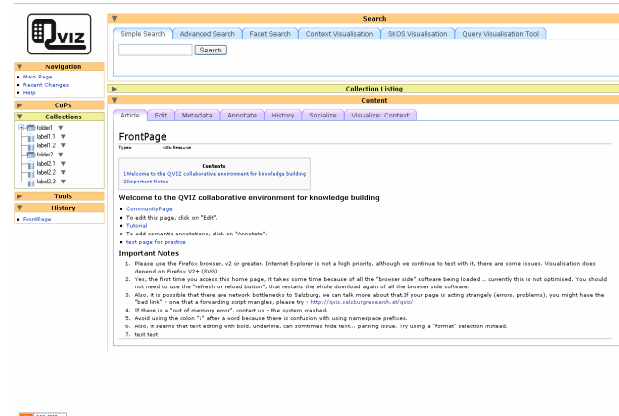
The Time-spatial interface as well as the faceted query component address querying and visualization for maps and administrative units. The Time-spatial interface enables map based browsing of administrative units of Estonia.

The user can zoom and pan over the map, displaying administrative units as polygons. A thematic coloring of the map can be chosen, with color representing the number of archival resources connected to an administrative unit. The collaborative environment presents a number of facets, drawn from the Estonian administrative unit ontology, which the user can activate, browse and order among each other.”
